

CURRICULUM & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Over 85 UC certified/approved courses offered
- Students are required to take 7 courses per year
- Traditional A-F grading system with plus/minus. There is no A+ grade
- GPAs are cumulative from grades 9-12 on a 4.0 scale
- Honors and AP courses are weighted with one extra point when calculating GPA
- 220 units in core subjects + 55 elective units required
- 24 AP and 12 Honors courses (82% AP exam pass rate)
